

Dress Code

ID Badges

All students are required to wear their ID badge on a break-away lanyard, visible around their necks at all times.

Replacement Id's will cost \$5 and replacement lanyards will cost \$3

Reason – To identify Lake Worth HS Students (safety)

Consequence – Placed on obligation list (no entrance to school activities), possible detentions.

Reward – Chance to participate in extra-curricular activities.

SHIRTS



Solid color polo style, or collared shirts in any solid color.

Shirts cannot show cleavage or midriff.

Approved Lake Worth High School T-Shirts/club shirts are allowed.

Team Athletic Shirts on game day are allowed.

Reason – To identify Lake Worth HS Students (safety)

Consequence – Must change clothes, placed on obligation list (no entrance to school activities), possible detentions.

Reward – Chance to participate in extra-curricular activities. Chance to show school spirit



Pants, Shorts and Capris



Solid color Pants, shorts, Capris and jeans must be worn at the natural waistline. Knee length shorts and skirts are acceptable (no slits).

Spandex or stretch material of any kind is not allowed

Holes, rips or tears in the material are not allowed.

Shorts must be to the kneecap.

All pants, shorts, Capris, jeans must fit correctly (not too loose or too tight)

Reason – Safety, appropriateness

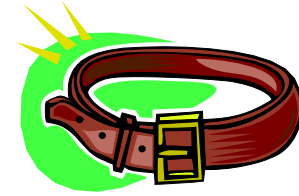
Consequence – Must change clothes, placed on obligation list (no entrance to school activities), progressive discipline.

SHOES AND BELTS



Any closed toe shoe and closed heel are acceptable.

Any type of heels should be worn with caution.

Sandals, crocs, slippers, and moccasins are not allowed.

Belt, if worn, must be correctly sized and worn in the pant loops

Reason – Safety, appropriateness

Consequence – Must change clothes, failure to comply will result in a discipline referral placed on obligation list (no entrance to school activities), progressive discipline .

Reward – Chance to participate in extra-curricular activities.

Hats and Accessories



No hats, caps, bandanas, or head covering (except for religious reasons) allowed on campus. This applies to both females and males.

No chains such as dog collars, wristbands, choke collars, chains on wallets, etc. (or other items) that may pose a safety hazard.



Gang related, drug related, alcohol related, death related, or anything promoting sex, violence or intolerance may not be worn or displayed.

Hats and Accessories

- **Reason** – Safety, inappropriate
- **Consequence** – Must remove articles, items, confiscated, failure to comply = placed on obligation list (no entrance to school activities) with discipline referral progressive discipline.
- **Reward** – Chance to participate in extra-curricular activities.

Students who are in violation of the dress code policy will be sent to Student Services for corrective action and or discipline as determined by the administration.
